High strength monobloc chassis in light alloy

Light profile forend with reinforcement points to achieve an overall rigidity, with an integrated Anschutz-type rail for mounting a bipod Muzzle thread protector (where provided)

Single-shot action in AISI 630 worked out from billet with a 20 MoA removable rail in light alloy

Bolt with two asymmetric rear lugs arranged at an angle of 60-degree lift, with a quick disassembly system, a double extractor and an ergonomic interchangeable bolt lever

PVD finish on the action and on the bolt
